Student Transportation's record for reliable yellow bus service is excellent.

However, during bad weather conditions, schedules for yellow buses cannot be guaranteed. During bad weather, a route can take up to 50 per cent longer or may be cancelled. Throughout the school year, parents or guardians are responsible for making sure that they have alternate plans in place for their children in case the yellow bus is late or does not arrive.

The final decision to send your child to the bus stop or to school rests with you, the parent or guardian, even though buses and schools may be operational.

In the event of bad weather, tune in to a local radio or TV station. If bus routes are cancelled, information will be broadcast. You can also check the *CityTV School Bus Monitor* at www.schoolbusmonitor.com/edmonton.



As your child's safety is our top priority, please follow these guidelines:

- Dress your child appropriately for the weather.
- Be at the stop 5 minutes before the scheduled pick-up time.
- Wait no longer than 10 minutes past scheduled arrival time.
- After 10 minutes, your child should return home (or to your chosen alternate location). Contact the bus company on your route:

- If contact cannot be made with the bus company, please call Student Transportation at 429-8585 or call your child's school.
- Have alternate arrangements in place for getting your child to school should the bus not arrive.
